

## ADA Transportation for Riders with Disabilities

MCTA; Pocono Pony recognizes that public transportation is a catalyst for social and economic opportunity for all populace. As a result, MCTA; Pocono Pony takes pride in offering everyone safe, comfortable and reliable service.

MCTA; Pocono Pony offers the following assistance for riders with disabilities and mobility limitations in conjunction with the Department of Transportation and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

- All public fixed route buses are equipped with a kneeling feature to make access easier.
- All fixed route buses are equipped with wheelchair lifts or ramps. Newer models contain fold-out ramps, making accessibility even easier.
- All operators will secure mobility devices that meet ADA requirements. Mobility devices can be no more than 30" wide x 48" long and no more than 600 lbs when occupied.
- MCTA will permit guide dogs or other service animals in compliance with the ADA.
- All fixed route buses may divert off route up to  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile to provide accessible transportation, provided the bus is able to do so safely.
- To accommodate riders with visual impairments, or any other disability, operators will call out stops when requested.
- Disabled persons may request special need accommodations in advance when traveling on any of our fixed route buses.

MCTA; Pocono Pony offers ADA Para transit services, *comparable public transportation for disabled persons unable to use our public fixed route buses due to a disability*. ADA Para transit applications can be down loaded from our *Schedules & Maps* page.
