

PUBLIC NOTICE DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) GOAL FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEARS 2020-22

Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 26, the Monroe County Transit Authority evaluated the availability of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises to provide goods and/or services needed by subrecipients of Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds in the State of Pennsylvania. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for Federal Fiscal Years 2020-2022 is proposed to be set at 1.5%.

The purpose of this notice is to afford the general public and disadvantaged businesses an opportunity to comment on the proposed program goal. The DBE program goal may be reviewed for 30 days beginning February 18, 2020 through March 19, 2020. Comments must be submitted in writing and sent to the mailing address or email address listed below no later than March 19, 2020.
